

RESOLUTION NO. 1521

RESOLUTION OF APPRECIATION FOR SUPPORT OF BOND ELECTION

WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Bond Election was held in this City on October 14, 1969, for the purpose of authorizing \$1,005,000 in bonds to finance the construction of a Sewage Disposal Plant and appurtenances; and

WHEREAS, the students of the Paso Robles High School; the members of the community Chamber of Commerce Bond Information and Support Committee; the Daily Press and its publisher, Ben O. Reddick; Radio Station K P R L and its owner, Ray Bryant; and many other interested citizens and organizations contributed substantially by their unselfish efforts in conveying the information needed by the voters of this City; and

WHEREAS, the voters of this City overwhelmingly supported the bond measure by a vote of 1,095 Yes votes to only 142 No votes; and


WHEREAS, the percentage of favorable votes is the highest recorded within the State of California within the past 5 years, a tribute to all those who worked so hard in support of the bond election.
