

RESOLUTION NO. 1792

REGIONAL PARKS - ALLOCATION OF STATE BOND FUNDS IN 1974

WHEREAS, a \$250 million bond issue for parks is to be presented to the voters in 1974; and


WHEREAS, if said bond issue is approved \$471,000 will be allocated to San Luis Obispo County for Regional Parks; and

WHEREAS, the San Luis Obispo County and Cities Area Planning Coordinating Council will consider the proposed allocation of funds; and

WHEREAS, the most equitable means of allocating the funds would be on a pro rata basis on the basis of population between the Cities and the County.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Paso Robles recommends and requests that these funds be allocated to each of the Cities and to the County as a whole on a population basis and that the City of Paso Robles Library Park and Sherwood Park, and parks designated along the Salinas River and in the Nacimiento areas be established as Regional Parks eligible for these funds.
