

RESOLUTION NO. 1345

A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ACQUIRE AND  
CONSTRUCT IMPROVEMENTS

EL PASO DE ROBLES IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 73-1

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Paso Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, California, that in its opinion the public interest and convenience require and that it is the intention of said Council to order the acquisitions and improvements more particularly described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. Whenever any public way is herein referred to as running between two public ways, or from or to any public way, the intersection of the public ways referred to are included to the extent that work shall be shown on the plans to be done therein.

2. Said streets and highways are more particularly shown in the records in the office of the City Clerk, City of Paso Robles, California, and shall be shown upon the plans herein referred to and to be filed with the City Clerk of said City.

3. All of said work and improvements are to be constructed at the places and in the particular locations, of the forms, sizes, dimensions and materials, and at the lines, grades and elevations as shown and delineated upon the plans, profiles and specifications to be made therefor, as hereinafter provided.

4. There is to be excepted from the work herein described any such work already done to line and grade and marked excepted or shown not to be done on said plans, profiles and specifications.

5. Notice is hereby given of the fact that in many cases said work and improvement will bring the finished work to a grade different from that formerly existing, and that to said extent said grades are hereby changed and that said work will be done to said changed grades.

6. Said Council does hereby adopt and establish as the official grades for said work the grades and elevations to be shown upon said plans, profiles and specifications. All such grades and elevations are to be in feet and decimals thereof with reference to the datum plane of the City.

7. The descriptions of the improvements and the termini of the work contained in this resolution are general in nature. All items of work do not necessarily extend for the full length of the description thereof. The plans and profiles of the work as contained in the Engineer's Report, shall be controlling as to the correct and detailed description thereof.

8. Said contemplated improvements, in the opinion of said Council, are of more than local or ordinary public benefit, and the costs and expenses thereof are made chargeable upon an assessment district, the exterior boundaries of which district are the composite and consolidated area as more particularly shown on a map thereof filed in the office of the City Clerk, to which reference is hereby made for further particulars. Said map indicates by a boundary line the extent of the territory included in the proposed district and shall govern all details as to the extent of the assessment district.

9. Said Council further declares that all public streets and highways within said assessment district in use in the performance of a public function as such shall be omitted from the assessment hereafter to be made to cover the costs and expenses of said improvements.

10. Notice is hereby given that serial bonds to represent the unpaid assessments, and bear interest at the rate of not to exceed seven percent (7%) per annum, will be issued hereunder in the manner provided in the Improvement Bond Act of 1915, Division 10 of the Streets and Highways Code, the last installment of which bonds shall mature not to exceed fourteen (14) years from the second day of July next succeeding ten (10) months from their date. The provisions of Part 11.1 of said Act, providing an alternative procedure for the advance payment of assessments and the calling of bonds, shall apply.

11. Except as herein otherwise provided for the issuance of bonds,

all of said improvements shall be done pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913.

12. Reference is hereby made to proceedings had pursuant to Division 4 of the Streets and Highways Code on file in the office of the City Clerk.

13. Said proposed improvements are hereby referred to the Engineer of Work, being a competent person employed by said Council for that purpose; and said Engineer is hereby directed to make and file with the City Clerk of said Council a report in writing, presenting the following:

(a) Plans and specifications of the proposed improvements to be made pursuant to this Resolution of Intention;

(b) Engineer's statement of the itemized and total estimated costs and expenses of said improvements and of the incidental expenses in connection therewith;

(c) Diagram showing the assessment district above referred to, and also the boundaries and dimensions of the respective subdivisions of land within said district as the same existed at the time of the passage of this Resolution of Intention, each of which subdivisions shall be given a separate number upon said diagram;

(d) A proposed assessment of the total amount of the costs and expenses of the proposed improvements upon the several subdivisions of land in said district in proportion to the estimated benefits to be received by such subdivisions, respectively, from said improvements, and of the expenses incidental thereto.

When any portion or percentage of the costs and expenses of the improvements is to be paid from sources other than assessments, the amount of such portion or percentage shall first be deducted from the total estimated costs and expenses of said improvements, and said assessment shall include only the remainder of the estimated costs and expenses. 
