

RESOLUTION NO. 2384

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES TO
THE SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION
RELATIVE TO ANNEXATION NO. 44

WHEREAS, petitions signed by the majority of property owners, requesting annexation of the hereinafter described area have been filed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES THAT:

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles hereby initiates proceedings to annex the area known as Annexation No. 44 and does request the San Luis Obispo County Local Agency Formation Commission to approve the Annexation of the territory described in the attached Exhibit "A".

THIS COUNCIL DECLARES THAT:

1. This Resolution is made pursuant to Section 35300 et sequel of the Government Code of the State of California.
2. That the territory proposed to be annexed is contiguous to the boundaries of the City.
3. That on January 2, 1980, at the hour of 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers is fixed as the time and place when and where the City Council will hear protests against this Annexation.
4. Protests shall be in writing and shall state the name of the owner of the property affected and the street address or other description of the property sufficient to identify it on the last equalized assessment roll. The metes and bounds description is not required if the property can be otherwise described in a manner sufficient to identify on the last equalized assessment roll.
5. The City Clerk is directed to cause a copy of this resolution to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City. Publication shall be complete at least

15 days before the date set for the hearing.

6. It is the intention of the City to annex the territory and the proceedings for the annexation of the territory have been initiated by Petitions to the City Council. The reasons that the residents and City Council desire annexation are as follows:
- A. All of the land proposed to be annexed is ideally located and situated for inclusion in the City limits.
 - B. The character of the territory is such that it requires and will benefit from Municipal Planning, Police Protection, Street Maintenance and other Municipal Services.


