

RESOLUTION NO. 2721

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING UNDERGROUND DISTRICT NO. 4

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2713, a public hearing called for Tuesday, April 6, 1982, at the hour of 7:30 P. M. in the City Council Chambers in the City Hall, Paso Robles, California, to ascertain whether the public necessity, health, safety or welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated structures, and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication or similar or associated services, within the boundaries of an area described as follows:

An area bounded on the west by the east line of Vine Street, on the north by the north line of 13th Street, on the east by the west line of Spring Street, and on the south by the north line of 12th Street;

and,

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given to all affected property owners as shown on the last equalized assessment roll and utilities concerned in the matter and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held, and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, that, pursuant to Title 15, Chapter 15.04 of the Municipal Code of the City of El Paso de Robles, the above described area is hereby declared an Underground Utility District, and is designated as Underground Utility District No. 4 of the City of El Paso de Robles.


RESOLVED FURTHER, that the City Council does hereby fix June 1, 1983, as the date on which affected property owners must be ready to receive underground service, and does hereby order that said underground service shall

be completed by August 1, 1983, and does hereby further order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communications, or similar or associated service within Underground Utility District No. 4, on or before December 1, 1983.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the City Clerk is hereby instructed to notify all affected utilities and all persons owning real property within Underground District No. 4 of the adoption of this resolution within ten (10) days after the date of such adoption. Said City Clerk shall further notify said property owners of the necessity that, if they or any person occupying such property desire to receive electric, communications or other similar or associated service, they or such occupant shall, by the date fixed in the resolution, provide all necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive such service from the lines of the supplying utility or utilities at the new location, subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility or utilities on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California. Such notification shall be made by mailing a copy of this resolution together with a copy of Title 15, Chapter 15.04 of the Municipal Code of the City of El Paso de Robles to affected property owners as such are shown on the last equalized assessment roll and to the affected utilities;


RESOLVED FURTHER, that the City Council finds that the Underground Utility District herein created is in the general public interest for reason that the undergrounding to be accomplished will avoid or eliminate an unusually heavy concentration of overhead distribution facilities.


