

RESOLUTION NO. 2726

A RESOLUTION CLOSING A STREET IN THE CITY OF
EL PASO DE ROBLES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, having on the 6th day of April, 1982, passed a Resolution of Intention to close and vacate a portion of a public street in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, which is more particularly described as follows:

That portion of 17th Street (80 Feet) from the west line of Riverside Avenue (80 Feet) to the east boundary of the Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way.

WHEREAS, it now appears that the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles did cause said Resolution of Intention to be published in the Paso Robles Daily Press as required by law; and

WHEREAS, it further appears that said notices and publications were in all respects as required by the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the State of California entitled "Street Vacation Act of 1941", Division IX, Part 3, Chapters 1 and 2 of the Streets and Highways Code; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held on said proposed closing as so noticed and having heard all evidence offered by any person interested, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles finds that the street as described is unnecessary for present or prospective future public street purposes.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the public street easement cease on said street hereinbefore described and be vacated for public street purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the entire 80 feet of right-of-way included in that portion of 17th Street described above shall be reserved as a public utilities easement in which the following shall apply:


1. "EXCERPTING AND RESERVING THEREFROM PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF Section 8340 of the Street and Highways Code and for the benefit of the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, the permanent easement and the right at any time or from time to time to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cable, wires, poles and other convenient struc-

tures, equipment and fixtures for the operation of telegraphic and telephone lines and other communication facilities, including access and the right to keep the property free from inflammable materials and wood growth, and otherwise protect the same from all hazards, in upon, over and across that portion of 17th Street, between Riverside Avenue and the Southern Pacific Railroad or part thereof."


2. "Reserving however to Pacific Gas and Electric Company the right from time to time to install, maintain, repair, operate, replace, remove and renew lines of pipes, wires, poles, and other structures, equipment and fixtures both above and underground for the operation of said facilities in said street."
3. Reserving to the Southern California Gas Company, Sonic Cable TV Company, and the City of Paso Robles, the right of entry to maintain their overhead and underground facilities.

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER, that the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of San Luis Obispo County, State of California.

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
