A RESOLUTION WITHDRAWING FROM MEMBERSHIP IN THE
CENTRAL COAST REGIONAL CRIMINAL JUSTICE PLANNING BOARD


WHEREAS, the Central Coast Regional Criminal Justice Planning Board (CCCJ), on February 18, 1982, voted to close down its Region P office, and

WHEREAS, this action was necessitated primarily by the elimination of the Federal Law Enforcement Assistance Administration with its funding allocation, and


WHEREAS, it is necessary to dissolve the Joint Powers Agreement which established the San Luis Obispo and Santa Barbara Counties Crime Control Joint Powers Agreement in 1975.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, hereby withdraws from membership in the Central Coast Regional Criminal Justice Planning Board as of June 30, 1982 and vests authority in the Board Chairman, Director and Fiscal Officer to perform all tasks necessary to pay and to perform outstanding obligations, close the books, and return any remaining funds to the State Office of Criminal Justice Planning.


