

RESOLUTION NO. 2799

A RESOLUTION GRANTING EASEMENT TO PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY

WHEREAS, in order for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to serve Tract 1054 with underground services an easement is necessary across City property; and

WHEREAS, said easement is described as follows:

PARCEL A as shown upon Parcel Map PR 80-154, filed for record in Book 30 of Parcel Maps at Page 8, San Luis Obispo County Records.

Said facilities shall consist of:

Such underground conduits, pipes, manholes, services boxes, wires, cables, and electrical conductors; aboveground marker posts, risers, and service pedestals; underground and aboveground switches, fuses, terminals, and transformers with associated concrete pads; and fixtures and appurtenances necessary to any and all thereof, as PG&E deems necessary located within the strip of land described as follows:

A strip of land of the uniform width of 10 feet extending from the westerly boundary line of said lands easterly, southerly, and easterly to the general southeasterly boundary line of said lands and lying 5 feet on each side of the line which begins at a point in said westerly boundary line and runs thence north $89^{\circ} 38.5'$ east 5.0 feet; thence south $0^{\circ} 21.5'$ east 21.5 feet; thence north $88^{\circ} 58.5'$ east approximately 24 feet to a point in said general southeasterly boundary line; said point of beginning being the northeast corner of LOT 9 of Tract 656, Unit No. 1, as said lot is shown upon the map filed for record in Book 10 of Maps at Page 25, San Luis Obispo County Records.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City hereby grants to Pacific Gas and Electric Company the above described easement and consents to its recordation by a duly authorized officer.
