## RESOLUTION NO. 2809

### A RESOLUTION APPROVING STATE DISABILITY INSURANCE FOR THE GENERAL SERVICES BARGAINING UNIT ONLY

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles is a public agency employer as defined in Section 3501 of the Government Code; and

WHEREAS, all employees who are part of the General Services Unit represented by Service Employees International Union voted in the majority to join the California State Disability Insurance System; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to authorize State Disability Insurance only for that bargaining unit; and

WHEREAS, each employee who is a member of the General Services Unit will have withheld from his/her wages the contribution required for unemployment compensation disability benefits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of El Paso de Robles authorizes only the General Service Unit Employees to join State Disability Insurance under the Unemployment Insurance Code Section 710.5.


