

RESOLUTION NO. 2811

SETTING PRIORITIES FOR EXPENDITURES OF FAU FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States has, in the Surface Transportation Assistance Act of 1982 declared it to be in the national interest for Federal funds to be expended for highway projects on the Federal Aid Urban System; and

WHEREAS, the City of Paso Robles must submit a priority list designating specific areas for funding to be used for traffic signal installation for improvement of City transportation;



PASSED AND ADOPTED THIS 15th day of March, 1983 by the following vote:


