RESOLUTION NO. 2878

A RESOLUTION STATING THE POLICY OF
THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES CONCERNING GROWTH

WHEREAS, the regional press has indicated that the City of El Paso de Robles may be turning to a no-growth philosophy; and,

WHEREAS, discussions involving moratoria have confused many developers and citizens of Paso Robles as to the policy toward industrial, commercial and residential growth in the future; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles desires to clarify their position regarding growth management;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that the following points constitute the policy of the City of El Paso de Robles toward growth;

1. Paso Robles needs to grow in a balanced manner, encouraging job development, shopping opportunities and housing facilities.
2. Sustained growth can and will be managed in such a way as to provide lasting economic, social, civic, and cultural benefits to all citizens of Paso Robles.
3. The City Council of the City of Paso Robles, has a great deal of faith in the future of Paso Robles as a community, as an economic force, and as a positive family environment. Consequently, it welcomes growth along the lines of the comprehensive plan as a viable and desirable method to assure the quality of life which is expected in the Paso Robles area.
