A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
APPROVING A POLICY STATEMENT FOR THE SALINAS RIVER CORRIDOR

WHEREAS, The General Plan identifies the preservation of natural resources such as the Salinas River, and

WHEREAS, the County's Parks and Recreation Department made a presentation at the July 21, 1992, Council meeting, informing the Council that the County is gathering citizen comment on the development of a Salinas River Plan, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was conducted by the City Council on September 15, 1992, to consider facts as presented in the staff report and to accept public testimony regarding this proposed policy statement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of El Paso De Robles does hereby adopt the following policy statement for the Salinas River corridor:

SALINAS RIVER CORRIDOR POLICY STATEMENT

The following list outlines the City of El Paso de Robles' current interests and concerns for the Salinas River Corridor:

1. To respect property owners' rights and the use of their land and take reasonable steps to minimize liability.
2. To retain riverbed access for community facilities and recreation for City owned or controlled properties.
