A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
OUTLINING ITS FISCAL YEAR 1992/93
CITY MANAGER PERFORMANCE & COMPENSATION PROGRAM PARAMETERS

WHEREAS, Richard J. Ramirez has served in the post of City Manager for a period of one year; and

WHEREAS, Richard J. Ramirez has successfully managed the City organization through a period of economic difficulty and uncertainty; and

WHEREAS, the City Council acknowledges and commends Richard J. Ramirez upon his performance through his first year as the City Manager of the City of El Paso de Robles; and

WHEREAS, the City continues to face the uncertainty of Statewide economic stagnation; and

WHEREAS, fiscal prudence compels the City Council to forego consideration of a salary adjustment for the City Manager during Fiscal Year 1992/93; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide broad policy and program direction to the City Manager in his ongoing efforts to manage the City organization;




Temporarily suspend compensation adjustment for the City Manager during Fiscal Year 1992/93; and
