**A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES FOR VACATING AN UNNAMED ROAD IN THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES AND GIVING NOTICE OF A TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING THEREON**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES does hereby resolve as follows:

1. That it is the intention of the City Council to close and vacate a public right-of-way in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, and more particularly described as follows:

That portion of real property described as Unnamed Road, as shown on map of the City of El Paso de Robles, filed in Book A of Maps at page 169 in the office of the county Recorder, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California. Said road also is shown in Book 52 at Page 100 of Licensed Surveys, also recorded in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California. Said road is sixty feet wide and lies north of Twelfth Street and south of Seventeenth Street, east of Villa Lot 35 (per A M.B. 169) and westerly of Villa Lots 4 and 5 (per A M.B. 169).

2. For further particulars as to the proposed vacation, reference, is hereby made to a map now on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Paso Robles.

3. That in the event of said closing, as hereby and above described, the City of Paso Robles may reserve a permanent public utility, water, sewer, drainage and access easement over the entire vacated street.

4. That **January 5, 1993**, at the hour of **7:30 P.M.**, on said date in the **Paso Robles School District Board Room, 800 Niblick Road**, Paso Robles, California, is the time and place set forth for hearing all persons interested in or having objection to the proposed closing.

5. That the City Clerk of the City of Paso Robles be and is hereby directed to cause a copy of this Resolution of Intention to be published **fifteen (15) days** prior to the date set herein for hearing in the Paso Robles Country News, a newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Paso Robles, California.

6. The City Engineer of the City of Paso Robles be and is hereby directed to cause a notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention and the time and place set for hearing hereon by conspicuously posting notices thereof along the line of the public right-of-way to be closed.
