

RESOLUTION NO. 92-186

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
AWARDING BIDS FOR DEMOLITION OF 1030 & 1004 SPRING & 744 11TH STREETS
AND ACQUISITION OF PREFABRICATED BUILDINGS
FOR POLICE STATION EXPANSION & TEMPORARY GREYHOUND BUS DEPOT**

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the highest and best interest of the City to demolish 1030 Spring Street, 1004 Spring Street, and 744 11th Street to create space to construct a new Public Library; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has further determined that temporary expansion of the City Police Station, and temporary relocation of the Greyhound Bus Depot, meets interim facility needs, and these temporary facilities are best developed through the acquisition and installation of prefabricated buildings; and

WHEREAS, quotations were requested and received to provide demolition and removal of said structures, and acquisition of the prefabricated buildings; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to enter into an agreement with Hintz Enterprises of Burbank, California to provide the demolition service, and purchase the prefabricated buildings from Mobile Modular subject to conditions outlined below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that:


- 1) The City Manager is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract with Hintz Enterprises in the amount of \$53,455.00 for the demolition and removal of the structures located at 1030 & 1004 Spring Street and 744 11th Street - work to commence upon receipt of Notice to Proceed estimated on or about January 4, 1993.
- 2) The bid for prefabricated building purchase and installation is awarded to Mobile Modular in the amount of \$95,134.00 (+ up to 10% additional for structure modifications) subject to pre-purchase City staff inspection and acceptance; should the units appear unsatisfactory, bid award is authorized to next lowest bidder - Space Leasing, in the amount of \$126,777.00.
