

RESOLUTION NO. 93-141

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
AFFIRMING THE CITY'S INTEREST IN OBTAINING APPROVAL OF
AND FUNDING FOR VARIOUS SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS
WITHIN THE CITY AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY ENGINEER TO REPRESENT
THE CITY IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING THERETO

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Paso Robles desires to seek certain Surface Transportation Program (STP) Local and Regional Funds for qualified projects within the City; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to making application for said STP funds, the City Council must, by Resolution, delegate authority to a City officer who is qualified determine and certify that the City satisfies the screening criteria for the subject application; and,

WHEREAS, for the purposes of placing said authority with a person who will responsibly and adequately be accountable for this task, the City Engineer is appropriate for this role; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to invest its entire six-year target local allocation into the Spring Street Overlay - 1993 Project; and,

WHEREAS, the three candidate projects that the City has submitted for consideration by the San Luis Obispo Council of Governments (SLOCOG) are to be ranked in order of the City Council's priorities; and,

WHEREAS, the City is required to certify that any or all of said candidate projects for Regional STP Funds can or will be expended within 24 months of SLOCOG's approval action.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City of Paso Robles hereby affirms its resolve to seek the entire six-year targeted allocation of Local STP Funds (estimated to be \$510,000.00) for resurfacing of the Spring Street.

Section 2. That the City of Paso Robles hereby affirms its resolve to seek the a portion of the **Regional STP/SHA Funds** for the following prioritized candidate projects:

First Priority **City of Paso Robles Transit Acquisitions** in the amount of \$100,000.00

Second Priority **Goldenhill Road/Highway 46 East Traffic Signal System** in the amount of \$175,000.00

Third Priority **Niblick Road Widening/Bikeway/Pedestrian Walk Project (South River Road to Quarterhorse Lane)** in the amount of \$250,000.00.

Section 3. That the City certifies that said candidate projects meet the criteria for STP projects and that any, or all, funds for said projects can and will be expended by the City within 24 months of SLOCOG approval.

Section 4. That the City of Paso Robles hereby appoints and authorized the City Engineer to represent the City in all matters pertaining the application for and processing of applications and requests for reimbursement funds for said Surface Transportation Program Projects.


