

RESOLUTION NO. 94-03

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
TO COMPLY WITH THE CALIFORNIA TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION'S
POLICY FOR HAZARDOUS WASTE IDENTIFICATION AND CLEAN UP (G-91-2)

WHEREAS, the City of Paso Robles is the lead agency for the acquisition of property, construction and operation of an intercity multimodal rail station using State Proposition 116 funds, and

WHEREAS, the City of Paso Robles accepted applicant status when it was transferred from the San Luis Obispo Council of Governments, and

WHEREAS, the City of Paso Robles has conducted a feasibility study for the proposed multimodal facility and found the project to be practical, and

WHEREAS, The San Luis Obispo Rail Improvement Feasibility Study determined that approximately 16,748 annual passengers would use the Paso Robles intercity rail station rail station if a San Francisco to Los Angeles train were added in addition to the Coast Starlight, and

WHEREAS, the City of Paso Robles has been negotiating with Railroad to transfer title of the property to the City, and

WHEREAS, staff of the California Transportation Commission have identified various certifications required prior to approving Proposition 116 grant funding.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Paso Robles certifies that all reasonable steps will be taken to assure due diligence in the discovery of hazardous waste and the State will be held harmless from clean-up liabilities, both present and future.
2. Additional State funds will not be sought for clean-up, damages or liability costs associated with hazardous wastes on or below the acquired properties surface.
3. The clean-up of hazardous wastes, if discovered, will be completed prior to acquisition.


4. The City of Paso Robles will attempt to secure a certification from whom the property has been acquired retaining liability for any hazardous waste investigation, clean-up and damages discovered subsequent to the transfer of title.
