

**A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION FOR VACATING A PORTION OF
CANYON CREST LANE IN TRACT 1508-2
GIVING NOTICE OF A TIME AND PLACE FOR
A PUBLIC HEARING THEREON**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES does hereby resolve as follows:

1. That it is the intention of the City Council to close and vacate a street in Tract 1508-2, in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, and more particularly described as follows:

That portion of Canyon Crest Lane in Tract 1508-2, from the northerly line of Canyon Crest Lane cul-de-sac to the northerly boundary of said Tract 1508-2, in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California as shown in Book 15, Page 84 of Maps on file in the County Recorder's Office of said County and State.

2. For further particulars as to the proposed vacation, reference, is hereby made to a map and plan now on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Paso Robles.

3. That February 1, 1994, at the hour of 7:30 P.M., on said date in the **Paso Robles School District Board Room, 800 Niblick Road, Paso Robles, California**, is the time and place set forth for hearing all persons interested in or having objection to the proposed closing.


4. That the City Clerk of the City of Paso Robles be and is hereby directed to cause a copy of this Resolution of Intention to be published **fifteen (15) days** prior to the date set herein for hearing in the Paso Robles Country News, a newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Paso Robles, California.

5. The City Engineer of the City of Paso Robles be and is hereby directed to cause a notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention and the time and place set for hearing hereon by conspicuously posting notices thereof along the line of the street to be vacated.
