

RESOLUTION NO. 94- 10

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
ACCEPTING A NON-MONETARY CONTRIBUTION
TO THE CITY FROM BICKELL'S STATIONARY
AND OFFICE SUPPLIES AND THE HAWORTH COMPANY

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso de Robles (the "City") is in the process of constructing a new public library for the City; and

WHEREAS, Bickell's Stationary offered on November 16, 1993 to contribute to the City free transportation for persons designated by the City to tour its furniture manufacturing facilities as well as those of Herman Miller; and

WHEREAS, the City has exercised substantial control over the use of this non-monetary contribution to the City; and

WHEREAS, Bickell's and/or Haworth did not limit the use of its non-monetary contribution to any particular officials or employees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles hereby resolve as follows:

Section 1. The City has accepted the non-monetary contribution from Bickell's and Haworth.


Section 2. The City, in its sole discretion, has determined how the contribution was to be used.
