

**RESOLUTION NO. 94-14**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES  
AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF \$10,000.00 OF  
UNAPPROPRIATED GENERAL FUND RESERVES TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT  
FOR THE PURCHASE OF "TURNOUT" SAFETY CLOTHING**

**WHEREAS**, in the development of the 1993/94 Fire Department budget, an effort was made to keep expenditures to a minimum and only \$11,000 was requested for the purchase of much needed firefighter safety clothing; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fire Department has not previously purchased a significant quantity of safety clothing at one time; items have been purchased on an "as needed" basis; and

**WHEREAS**, much of the safety clothing utilized by Paso Robles Volunteer Firefighters is either beyond repair, antiquated or missing; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fire Department cannot currently supply all personnel with safety clothing items or replace lost or damaged clothing should the need arise; and

**WHEREAS**, an approximate cost of firefighter safety clothing, "turnouts" (which includes coat, pants, helmet and boots), is \$1,000.00 per firefighter.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles hereby authorize the appropriation of \$10,000.00 of unappropriated general fund reserves to Fire Department account 100.220.5212 for the purchase of "turnout" safety clothing.
