

RESOLUTION NO. 94 - 15

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES,
CALIFORNIA, CALLING A GENERAL MUNICIPAL
ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY ON TUESDAY,
JUNE 7, 1994, FOR SUBMITTING A PROPOSITION
THAT THE OFFICES OF CLERK AND TREASURER BE
APPOINTIVE AND SPECIFYING THE DEADLINE FOR
SUBMISSION OF ARGUMENTS FOR AND AGAINST THE MEASURE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES DOES
HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to section 36508 of the California Government Code and to the laws of the State of California relating to municipal elections, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles hereby calls and orders to be held on Tuesday, June 7, 1994, in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, a general municipal election for the purpose of placing on the ballot the following measure:

Measure "A"

Shall the offices of city clerk and city treasurer be appointive?

Section 2. Said election shall be held and consolidated with the statewide election to be held on June 7, 1994. In all particulars not recited in this Resolution, said election shall be conducted as provided by law for the holding of municipal elections in the City.

Section 3. Arguments for or against said measure shall be filed with the Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles on or before February 22, 1994, at 5:00 pm.

Section 4. Rebuttal arguments may be submitted as provided for in section 5014.5 of the California Elections Code. The provisions of said section 5014.5 are hereby adopted and shall apply to this election.

Section 5. References in Resolution 94-11, adopted by the City Council on January 4, 1994, regarding the election of a city clerk and a city treasurer and their respective terms of office are hereby deleted and repealed. The general municipal


election called for June 7, 1994, shall not include an election of a city clerk or a city treasurer.


