

**RESOLUTION NO. 94-40**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
EL PASO DE ROBLES, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 94-11,  
REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN  
LUIS OBISPO TO CONSOLIDATE A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION  
TO BE HELD ON JUNE 7, 1994 WITH THE STATEWIDE PRIMARY  
ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE DATE PURSUANT TO  
SECTION 23302 OF THE ELECTIONS CODE**

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**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles called a Municipal Election to be held on June 7, 1994 for the purpose of the election of two (2) Members of the City Council for full terms of four (4) years; a City Clerk for a full term of four (4) years, and a City Treasurer, for a full term of four (4) years; and;

**WHEREAS**, in adopting Resolution No. 94-11, the City of El Paso de Robles incorrectly included the election of a City Clerk and City Treasurer.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** That pursuant to the requirements of Section 23302 of the Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo is hereby requested to consent and agree to the Primary Election on Tuesday, June 7, 1994, for the purpose of the election of two (2) Members of the City Council for full terms of four (4) years.

**SECTION 2.** References in Resolution No. 94-11, adopted by the City Council on January 4, 1994, regarding the election of a City Clerk and a City Treasurer and their respective terms of office are hereby deleted and repealed. The general municipal election called for June 7, 1994, shall not include an election of a City Clerk or a City Treasurer.

**SECTION 3.** That the County Election Department is authorized to canvass the returns of the Primary Municipal Election. The election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used.

**SECTION 4.** That the Board of Supervisors is requested to issue instructions to the County Election Department to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election.

**SECTION 5.** That the City of El Paso de Robles recognizes that additional


costs will be incurred by the County by reasons of this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County for any costs.

**SECTION 6.** That the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the County Election Department of the County of San Luis Obispo.


**SECTION 7.** That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
