

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICES TO SECURE GRANT FUNDING IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE CENTRAL COAST COMMUNITY SERVICE COALITION.

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Services, City of Paso Robles has developed a Youth Task Force with various agencies.

WHEREAS, the Youth Task Force has established programs dealing with Juvenile Diversion, positive alternatives to reduce gang activity, violence and negative behavior. Alternatives include, but are not limited to, education, recreation, employment, cultural arts, afterschool programs, mentoring, tutoring, crisis intervention and prevention.

WHEREAS, funds are available through the Learn and Serve America Community Based Grant.

WHEREAS, through the format of the Central Coast Community Service Coalition, a county wide collaboration, and whereas, the City of Paso Robles has been asked to be the Lead Agency in obtaining grant funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council approves the Department of Community Services to act as the Lead Agency for the Central Coast Community Service Coalition through the Learn and Serve America Community Based Grant effective May 10, 1994.

Section 2. The Executive Manager of the Department of Community Services is hereby authorized and directed to take any actions or execute any documents as may be necessary to carry out the grant funding on behalf of the City, and to carry out the purposes of this Resolution.
