

RESOLUTION No. 98-07

**A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION FOR VACATING A PORTION OF
AN ALLEY BETWEEN 26TH AND 28TH STREETS AND GIVING NOTICE
OF A TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING THEREON**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES does hereby resolve as follows:

1. That it is the intention of the City Council to close and vacate approximately 4,520 square feet of an alley between 26th and 28th Streets and more particularly described in the attached Exhibit 'A.'

2. For further particulars as to the proposed vacation, reference is thereby made to a map and plan now on file in the office of City Clerk of the City of Paso Robles.

3. That **February 17, 1998**, at the hour of **7:30 P.M.**, on said date in the **Conference Room of the City Hall offices at 1000 Spring Street, Paso Robles, California**, is the time and place set forth for hearing all persons interested in or having objection to the proposed closing.

4. That the City Clerk of the City of Paso Robles be and is hereby directed to cause a copy of this Resolution of Intention to be published fifteen (15) days prior to the date set herein for hearing in the Country News Press, a newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Paso Robles, California.

5. The City Engineer of the City of Paso Robles be and is hereby directed to cause a notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention and the time and place for hearing hereon by conspicuously posting notices thereof along the line of the alley to be vacated.
