

RESOLUTION NO. 98-26

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING CONSOLIDATION OF ELECTION
AND ORDERING OF SUCH ELECTION,
AND APPROVING A TAX RATE STATEMENT**

WHEREAS, City of El Paso de Robles orders that an election be held June 2, 1998 for the purposes of:

Submitting to the voters a measure to incur a general obligation bond indebtedness to pay for the cost of construction of certain municipal improvements and facilities.

WHEREAS, whenever two or more elections of any district, city, county, or other public subdivision are called to be held on the same day, in the same territory, or in territory that is in part the same, they may be consolidated upon the order of the governing body, or officer calling the elections (Elections Code Section 10400) and pursuant to the procedures for consolidation with a statewide election (Elections Code Section 10402);

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elections Code Section 10400, whenever one of the elections to be consolidated is a statewide election, the district, city, county, or other political subdivision shall file with the Board of Supervisors and file a copy with the County Clerk, a resolution of its governing board requesting such consolidation and setting forth the exact form of any question, proposition or office to be voted upon at such election as the same is to appear on the ballot. Upon such request, the Board of Supervisors may order the consolidation;

WHEREAS, various district, county, and statewide and other political subdivision elections have been or may be called to be held on June 2, 1998;

WHEREAS, Section 9401 et seq. of the Elections Code requires that a tax rate statement be contained in all official publications and ballot pamphlets prepared, sponsored and published by the City which relate to said election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED as follows:

1. That the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles hereby orders an election be called and consolidated with any and all elections also called to be held on June 2, 1998 insofar as said elections are to be

held in the same territory or in territory that is in part the same as the territory of the City of El Paso de Robles and request the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo to order such consolidation under Elections Code Section 10400.

2. That the form of ballot question to be presented to the voters and to be placed on the June 2, 1998 ballot shall read as follows:

City of El Paso de Robles Bond Measure

3. That all of the purposes enumerated in the foregoing proposition shall be united and voted upon as one single proposition.
4. That the Mayor of the City is hereby authorized to prepare a tax rate statement (the "Tax Rate Statement") conforming to the requirements of Section 9401 of the Elections Code, and to file said Tax Rate Statement with the Registrar of Voters.
5. That the Registrar of Voters is hereby requested to include the Tax Rate Statement in all official publications pertaining to the Election, pursuant to the terms of Section 9402 of the Elections Code.
6. That the members of the Council are hereby authorized, but not directed, to prepare and file with the City Clerk a ballot argument in favor of the proposition set forth above, within the time established.
