

RESOLUTION NO. 98-31

OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES  
TO REVOKE RESOLUTION NO. 2367  
(ANNEXATION FEES)

WHEREAS, at the City Council meeting of January 20, 1998, the City Council considered a request from Tom Erskine and the President of iQuest Corporation for the City to provide financial relief to their proposed development on Golden Hill Road north of Highway 46 East; and

WHEREAS, the subject property is within the area that was annexed to the City as part of the so-called Northeast or Airport Annexation in 1990; and

WHEREAS, as a recently annexed property the subdivision or development of the property triggers payment of Annexation Fees established by City Council Resolution No. 2367, adopted in November 1979; and

WHEREAS, since 1979 the City has adopted other means to recover the cost of processing and infrastructure associated with the Annexation process, including but not limited to cost-recovery for Planning Application processing, Development Impact Fees, and Specific Plan Fees; and

WHEREAS, in response to the request by Mr. Erskine and the President of iQuest Corporation, and considering the changes in City fees and cost recovery since 1979, the City Council directed staff to return with a proposal to eliminate the Annexation Fee; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of El Paso de Robles hereby revokes City Council Resolution No. 2367, A Resolution Establishing Annexation Fees.
