

RESOLUTION NO. 98-56

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES AMENDING THE CITY'S  
CLASSIFICATION AND COMPENSATION PLAN

WHEREAS, Resolution 97-62 did establish and set forth, in a Memorandum of understanding, salaries and benefits for General Services Unit, Service Employees International Union represented workers; and

WHEREAS, Since the November 1996 retirement of the Fleet Superintendent, a shop mechanic has been acting as lead mechanic; and

WHEREAS, The Fleet Operation has been placed under the control of the Director of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, The Director of Public Works is confident that a lead worker can handle the day to day operations of the shop; and

WHEREAS, The Director of Public Works has recommended that the lead Mechanic position be made permanent; and


WHEREAS, The position of Fleet lead worker does not exist in the current Classification and Compensation Plan; and

WHEREAS, The Senior Mechanic (lead worker) job class has been reviewed and approved by representatives of the Service Employees International Union.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that the City Classification and Compensation Plan is hereby amended to establish a new Senior Mechanic classification. Senior Mechanic classification as per exhibit attached hereto and include herein by reference.
