

RESOLUTION NO. 98-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES IDENTIFYING
FUNDING RESOURCES FOR THE REGIONAL
TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City has an opportunity to submit a Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) application for partial funding of qualified projects; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified two projects which meet the minimum qualifications for RTIP funding, the Niblick Bridge Expansion Project and the 13th Street Bridge Expansion Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council has chosen the Niblick Bridge Expansion Project as its first choice should RTIP resources be available and the project approved by the San Luis Obispo Council of Governments (SLOCOG); and

WHEREAS, should available RTIP resources not be sufficient to fund the Niblick Bridge Expansion Project, the Council has chosen the 13th Street Bridge Expansion Project as a second option for SLOCOG since it requires considerably less funding resources; and

WHEREAS, the RTIP requires a local funding contribution (match) in a like ratio as the ratio of local versus regional benefit of the project being considered; and

WHEREAS, SLOCOG does require the Agency, submitting an application for RTIP funding, to identify said local resources for the match in order to illustrate that the project is fully funded.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does hereby approve Option "C", as identified in the staff report dated 1/20/98:

Option C - Short-term Internal Borrowing

Public Facilities Fees (PFF) thru 6/30/98	\$ 30,000
PFF thru 6/30/02	240,000
Internal Borrowing (structured over 5 yrs. from increased sales tax revenues)	1,230,000

Federal Demonstration	\$1.5 million
Public Facilities Fees	.5 million
Woodland Plaza II OPA	2.0 million

Section 2. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles direct staff to submit a request to SLOCOG for a 50% match (\$5.5 million) from the Regional


Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) to widen Niblick Road Bridge as a first priority.

Section 4. That a 2.2% escalation rate shall be added to the request.

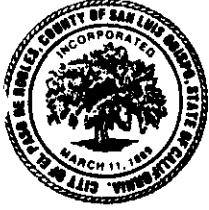
