

RESOLUTION No. 98-60

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
APPROPRIATING FUNDING FOR THE DEVELOPMENT
OF BARNEY SCHWARTZ PARK**

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of April 7, 1998, the City Council tentatively agreed to a maximum of \$200,000.00 in contributions for the development of Barney Schwartz Park; and

WHEREAS, \$50,000.00 would initially be contributed for volunteer startup, engineering and design work, with a potential for an additional amount up to a maximum of \$150,000.00 in contributions in the future; and

WHEREAS, contributions will be contingent upon the volunteer Sports Park Task Force meeting certain benchmarks and/or milestones as determined and accepted by the City; and

WHEREAS, funding for the contributions will come from General Reserve and Contingency Fund reserves; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby appropriate \$75,000.00 in Fiscal Year 1997-1998, and \$125,000.00 in Fiscal Year 1998-1999, from General Reserve and Contingency Fund reserves for the purposes of contributions to the development Barney Schwartz Park to budget account 110.910.5452.621.

Section 2. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby make all contributions contingent upon the volunteer Sports Park Task Force meeting certain benchmarks and/or milestones as determined and accepted by the City.

Section 3. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby authorize staff to develop a list of specific benchmarks and/or milestones to be met by the volunteer Sports Park Task Force to be placed on a future agenda for approval.


