

RESOLUTION No. 98-67

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
REPEALING TIME LIMIT PARKING FOR
TWO DOWNTOWN PARKING LOTS**

WHEREAS, the three hour time limit for parking lots in the downtown area was set by past City Council by resolution; and

WHEREAS, since that time, conditions have changed and there have been requests to remove the time limit parking to permit longer parking time in these lots; and


WHEREAS, it now appears that this parking limit is no longer needed and longer term parking may be advantageous in these lots.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby remove time limits for parking in two downtown area parking lots: 1) parking lot on west side of Spring Street between 12th and 13th Street; 2) parking lot near the Elks Lodge on Park Street.
