

RESOLUTION No. 98-71

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES  
INITIATING PROCEEDINGS FOR ANNUAL LEVY OF ASSESSMENTS  
FOR THE EL PASO DE ROBLES LANDSCAPE AND LIGHTING  
DISTRICT No. 1 - FISCAL YEAR 1998-1999  
PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PART 2 OF DIVISION 15  
OF THE CALIFORNIA STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE

WHEREAS, the City Council has, by previous Resolutions, formed the El Paso De Robles Landscape and Lighting Assessment District No. 1 (hereinafter referred to as "District") pursuant to the provisions of the *Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, Part 2 of Division 15 of the Streets and Highways Code of California, beginning with Section 22500* (hereafter referred to as the "Act"), that provides for levy and collection of assessments by the County of San Luis Obispo for the City of El Paso De Robles to provide for the maintenance and services of lighting facilities, landscaping, and all appurtenant facilities and operations related thereto; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has retained MuniFinancial, Inc, for the purpose of assisting with the annual levy of the District, and to prepare and file a report with the City Clerk in accordance with the Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND DETERMINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Council hereby orders MuniFinancial, Inc. to prepare the annual levy report concerning the levy of assessments for the District in accordance with *Chapter 3, Section 22622* of the Act.

Section 2: The improvements within the District include: the maintenance, operation of and the furnishing of services and materials for street lighting facilities, detention basins, open space areas, landscaping, irrigation systems, bike paths, pedestrian pathways, slope maintenance, graffiti abatement, local parks, entry monuments. Landscaping including trees, shrubs, grass and other ornamental vegetation, and appurtenant facilities, including irrigation systems, and drainage devices, within the District. The annual levy report describes all new improvements or substantial changes in existing improvements. There are no proposed increases for fiscal year 1998-1999 over those assessment amounts for 1997-1998 fiscal year.
