

RESOLUTION No. 98-84

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
AUTHORIZING USAGE OF A SEPTIC SYSTEM ON PARCEL 1,
PER PLANNED DEVELOPMENT NO. 96-010 (TOM SCHULTZ)**

WHEREAS, the City has received a request for permission to utilize a septic tank and leach field on Parcel 1 of PR 97-229 for Tom Schultz; and

WHEREAS, per Planned Development No. 96-010 the applicant, Tom Schultz, is required to utilize a septic system until such time as sewer facilities are available to the project site; and

WHEREAS, the City Municipal Code, Section 14.08.020 prohibits septic systems within the City limits, unless sewer facilities are not available.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby adopt this Resolution authorizing usage of a septic tank and leach field at the aforementioned project site.

Section 2. That the applicant comply with the City's requirements and procedures regarding the use of septic tanks, including, but not limited to, payment of monitoring fees, or any other items as may be necessary as required by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board and/or the Director of Public Works.


Section 3. That the applicant is required to connect to a future sewerage system immediately upon receipt of written notification by the City of such availability in accordance with provisions of the Operations Code.

Section 4. That the applicant shall, prior to constructing said connection, pay all connection and sanitary sewer main extension and reimbursement fees as required in effect at the time.

Section 5. That upon connection to a future sewer system the applicant is required to properly abandon the existing septic system within sixty calendar days of connection to the City's sewerage system.
