

RESOLUTION No. 99-85

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES, CALIFORNIA,
GIVING PERMISSION TO REMOVE AN OAK TREE AT AIRPORT ROAD (TENTATIVE TRACT 2276)**

WHEREAS, the City has received an arborist report dated September 30, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the health of the tree has deteriorated and is severely infected with heart rot.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby give permission for the removal of one (1) oak tree at Airport Road as part of the development of Tentative Tract 2276.

Section 2. That the applicant is required to install two (2) 24-inch box oak trees (1-1/2 inch minimum caliper) for each oak tree removed which are greater than 3-inch diameter.
