

RESOLUTION NO. 02-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
ADOPTING A NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE TEMPLETON INTERCEPTOR UPGRADE
AND APPROVING PUBLIC WORKS PROJECT NO. DPW 01-01

WHEREAS, pursuant to the 1993 Sewer Master Plan and 1991 General Plan Update the City of El Paso de Robles (the "City") has initiated an upgrade to the Templeton Interceptor sewer main (the "Project") to consist of the following components:

1. Replace and enlarge the existing 12 inch main in "Reach 2" (a segment of the Templeton Interceptor), which runs parallel to the UPRR tracks between Volpi Isabel and Lift Station #2, which is located about 650 feet north of the northern terminus of Ramada Drive (at the UPRR tracks);
2. Replace and enlarge the existing 12 inch main in Reach 4, which is located in the right-of-way of South River Road, between Oak Lane and Serenade Drive;
3. Replace and enlarge the existing 8 inch main in Calle Propano that connects with the Templeton Interceptor;
4. Rehabilitate and upgrade Lift Station #2 by constructing a new wet well and improving the pumps; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act, the City has prepared an Initial Study for the Project, which concludes that the project will not have any significant effects on the environment and recommends that a Negative Declaration be adopted; and

WHEREAS, public notice of the proposed Negative Declaration was given as required by Section 21092 of the Public Resources Code; and pursuant to said public notice, the public was given the opportunity to submit written comments and to appear before the City Council at a public meeting conducted on January 3, 2002 to make oral comments on the draft Negative Declaration; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Based on the information contained in the plans and specifications prepared for the Project on file with the City's Department of Public Works, the Initial Study prepared for the Project, public comments and testimony received during the comment period and at the public hearing conducted on January 3, 2002, the City Council finds, based on its independent judgment and analysis, that there is no substantial evidence that the Project will have a significant effect on the environment.

SECTION 2. The City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby approve and adopt the Negative Declaration for the Project. All of the documents and other evidence which constitute the record of proceedings upon which the findings in this Resolution are made are in the custody of the Department of Public Works, City Hall, 1000 Spring Street, Paso Robles, California 93446.

SECTION 3. The City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby approve the Project, and directs the City Clerk to file a Notice of Determination regarding the approval of the Project with the County Clerk of San Luis Obispo County for posting.
