

RESOLUTION NO. 02-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
APPROVING STREET NAME CHANGE 02-001 -
WILD MUSTARD LANE TO OAK RIDGE WAY

WHEREAS, Wild Mustard Lane begins within the Oak Meadows subdivision and continues and terminates within Tract 2281-5, Shadow Canyon, (see attached Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, As part of the approval of Tract 2281 it was required that a gate be put across Wild Mustard Lane at the eastern boundary of Oak Meadows since the access into Tract 2281 was for secondary emergency access; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Services Department has requested to change the name of the portion of Wild Mustard Lane within Tract 2281-5 since through traffic will not be able to continue on Wild Mustard Lane into the Shadow Canyon Tract (Tract 2281); and

WHEREAS, the proposed new name is Oak Ridge Way; and

WHEREAS, Wild Mustard Lane within Oak Meadows would not be changed; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Commission at their meeting of February 12, 2002, recommended approval of Street Name Change 02-001; and

WHEREAS, both Government Code (section 34091.1) and Streets & Highways Code (section 5026) allows the City to change a street name.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby approve the name change of Wild Mustard Lane within Tract 2281-5 to Oak Ridge Way.

SECTION 2. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles hereby authorizes staff to record the necessary documentation with the San Luis Obispo County Clerk and San Luis Obispo County Surveyor to effect the change of street name.
