

RESOLUTION NO. 02-37

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
RECOMMENDING APPROVAL OF THE DRAFT 2002 CONSOLIDATED PLAN FOR THE URBAN
COUNTY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO AND ITS RECOMMENDATIONS FOR ALLOCATIONS OF YEAR 2002
HOME AND ESG PROGRAM FUNDS

WHEREAS, on July 13, 1999 the City of El Paso de Robles (City) executed a Cooperation Agreement with the County of San Luis Obispo (County) to form an "Urban County" for purposes of allocating annual entitlements to the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnership (HOME) and Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) grant programs administered by the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, via the Cooperation Agreement, the City agree to cooperate in the preparation of the Consolidated Plan and the annual allocation of HOME and ESG funds; and

WHEREAS, on September 11, 2001, the urban county published a "Request for Proposals" for projects to be funded under the 2002 HOME and ESG Programs, which provided that proposals were to be submitted by October 29, 2001; and

WHEREAS, on October 11, 2001, the urban county conducted a public hearing in Paso Robles for residents of the City and of northern San Luis Obispo County to ascertain the housing and community development needs to be addressed in the Consolidated Plan; and

WHEREAS, on December 31, 2001, the urban county released a Draft 2002 Consolidated Plan for public review; and

WHEREAS, the Urban County expects to receive about \$1,286,000 in HOME funds and about \$95,000 in ESG funds in 2001; and

WHEREAS, no applications were filed for using HOME or ESG funds within City limits; and

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2002, the County published a notice in the Tribune, indicating that a public hearing would be conducted on the Draft 2002 Consolidated Plan on March 5, 2002; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of March 5, 2002, the City Council conducted a public hearing to obtain public testimony on the proposed Draft Consolidated Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, California, to recommend that the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Luis Obispo adopt the 2002 Consolidated Plan, a copy of which shall be kept on file in the Community Development Department, to include the activities listed below to be funded with the 2002 HOME and ESG funds.
