

RESOLUTION NO. 02-43

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND APPROVING THE RECRUITMENT OF PART-TIME STAFF
FOR NIGHTTIME SECURITY AND FACILITY MAINTENANCE AT
BARNEY SCHWARTZ PARK

WHEREAS, Barney Schwartz Park is scheduled to open June 8, 2002; and

WHEREAS, because of the park's relatively remote location in the northeast section of the City and the valuable assets located there, the City Council directed staff to explore options to annually fund off-hours security; and

WHEREAS, staff thoroughly analyzed three different staffing approaches and has determined that, at \$35,770 per year, the option of hiring part-time MSI Maintenance Staff (option "a" in the staff report), is the most fiscally responsible option, while still effectively serving security and light maintenance functions needed at Barney Schwartz Park; and

WHEREAS, in calendar year 2002, the period of April 1 through October 31 would be the prime period to initiate a large-scale project first phase.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby appropriate \$3,000 for fiscal year 2002 and \$36,000 for fiscal year 2003 to the Barney Schwartz Maintenance Budget No.100-310-5102-171.

SECTION 2. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby direct staff to recruit part-time staff (up to 3,000 hours annually) at the MSI level for security and light maintenance at Barney Schwartz Park.
