

RESOLUTION NO. 02-54

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL OF SEVEN OAK TREES AND TRIMMING OF
ONE OTHER OAK TREE AT 70 FRESNO STREET (VAUGHN)

WHEREAS, the City has received an application submitted by Don Vaughn, to remove seven (7) oak trees and pruning of one other tree located on the parcel located at 70 Fresno Street and

WHEREAS, nine (9) other oak trees would be retained, but impacted by the development of the lot; and

WHEREAS, an Arborist Report, dated January 14, 2002, was prepared by Jack Brazeal, Registered Consulting Arborist, describing impacts to the oak trees and recommended mitigation; and

WHEREAS, the trees are requested to be removed in order to construct a single-family residence on the property.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby authorize the removal of seven (7) oak trees ranging size from 5 inches to 16 inches on the parcel located at 70 Fresno Street.

SECTION 2. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby authorize the trimming of one limb on the 60-inch oak tree (Tree 1).

SECTION 3. That the applicant shall perform all mitigation measures to the oak trees as described in the Arborist Report dated January 14, 2002.

SECTION 4. That the applicant is required to install two (2) 24-inch box oak trees (1-½ inch minimum caliper) for each oak tree removed that is 6 inches or greater, either on site, or at a location as directed by the City's Superintendent of Streets.
