

RESOLUTION NO. 02-58

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES  
APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO PREPARE A TRAFFIC ANALYSIS,  
HIGHWAY 46 WEST / HIGHWAY 101 INTERCHANGE

WHEREAS, the City's Planning Commission has called for additional traffic analysis prior to considering a Negative Declaration and commercial development project in the vicinity of the Highway 46 West / Highway 101 Interchanges; and

WHEREAS, based on a Cooperative Agreement between the City, the Council of Governments, and the County of San Luis Obispo, the City is obligated to prepare a Project Study Report (PSR) for the subject interchange, and additional traffic modeling is required for the completion of the PSR; and

WHEREAS, there are a number of pending commercial developments in the subject area that would potentially impact the subject interchange, and there is a need for traffic analysis in order to ascertain the capacity of the interchange and means to increase that capacity; and

WHEREAS, one of the pending development projects has contributed their share of the subject study (\$9,000) and there is a need for the City of Paso Robles to pay for the balance of the traffic analysis (\$15,165); and

WHEREAS, the expenditure of City funds, will impact the Department's operating budget making it necessary that the City Council approve a one time budget appropriation for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles that a one time appropriation in the amount of \$15,200 from General Fund reserves to budget account 100-710-5224-209 is hereby approved.
