

RESOLUTION NO. 02-67

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
APPROVING THE REMOVAL OF AN OAK TREE AT 215 24TH STREET

WHEREAS, the City has received an application by Robbin Tidwell to remove one (1) double trunk (9-inch and 8.5-inch diameters) California Live Oak tree located on the parcel located at 215 24th Street; and

WHEREAS, this tree is situated close to the foundation of a proposed new residence; and

WHEREAS, an Arborist Report was included with the request performed by Jack Brazeal; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Brazeal has determined that site development will have a long term adverse effect on the tree and recommends that the tree be removed,.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby authorize the removal of the double trunk (9-inch and 8.5-inch diameters) oak tree on the parcel located at 215 24th Street.

SECTION 2. That the applicant is required to install two (2) 24-inch box oak trees (1-½ inch minimum caliper) for each oak tree removed, either on site or at a location as directed by the City's Superintendent of Streets.
