

RESOLUTION NO. 02-68

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL OF TWO OAK TREES (FOOD 4 LESS)

WHEREAS, the City has received an application submitted by SKW & Associates to remove two (2) oak trees located on the 9-acre parcel on the northeast corner of Sherwood Road and Creston Road; and

WHEREAS, two (2) other oak trees would be retained but impacted by the development of the lot, and

WHEREAS, an Arborist Report was received on March 14, 2002, prepared by Nelda Matheny, Certified Arborist of HortScience, describing impacts to the oak trees and recommended mitigation; and

WHEREAS, the trees are requested to be removed in order to construct a 90,408-square foot shopping center, which would include the Food 4 Less store on the property.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby authorize the removal of two (2) oak trees (Tree 1 and Tree 3 as shown on attached Exhibit A) ranging in size from 18 inches to 19 inches on the parcel located on the northeast corner of Creston Road and Sherwood (APN 009-571-020).

SECTION 2. That the applicant shall perform all mitigation measures to the oak trees as described in the Arborist Report received March 14, 2002.

SECTION 3. That the applicant is required to install two (2) 24-inch box blue oak trees (1-½ inch minimum caliper) for each oak tree removed that is 6 inches or greater (total of four [4] replacement trees) on site. Trees shall be shown on landscaping plan for the project.
