

RESOLUTION NO. 02-71

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES  
REJECTING ALL BIDS RECEIVED ON THE TEMPLETON INTERCEPTOR SEWER PROJECT  
AND DIRECTING STAFF TO RE-ADVERTISE FOR BIDS

WHEREAS, the Bid Opening for the Paso Robles Templeton Sewer Upgrades, Reaches 2 & 4 and Calle Propano was held on March 7, 2002 with twelve (12) bids received; and

WHEREAS, the apparent low bid was submitted by Specialty Construction; and

WHEREAS, the City received three (3) Bid Protests within the time frame limit as specified in the bid documents; and

WHEREAS, basis for the Bid Protestors is that the low bidders do not have the minimum level of experience for the pipe-bursting method of construction, as specified in the Bid Documents; and

WHEREAS, upon review by the City Attorney, it is recommended that the City Council reject all bids.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby reject all bids received for the Templeton Interceptor Sewer Project on March 7, 2002.

SECTION 2. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby direct staff to re-advertise for bids.
