

RESOLUTION NO. 02-87

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES  
APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE PUBLIC WORKS POOL BUDGETS TO PURCHASE AND  
INSTALL REPLACEMENT POOL DISINFECTION SYSTEMS FOR THREE POOLS

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WHEREAS, Municipal Pool, Therapy Pool and Centennial Pools require effective disinfection systems due to the fact that bather loads routinely exceed 300 people during hot summer days; and

WHEREAS, to maintain a healthy environment for bathers the County Health Department requires the maintenance of a constant chemical residual (2-5 ppm Chlorine or 5-11 ppm Bromine) be present in the pool water at all times; and

WHEREAS, the disinfection systems currently used (Bromine/Ozone) in all locations need either repair or replacement; and

WHEREAS, engineering estimates indicate repairs could cost \$12,000 or more depending upon findings by technicians once the components are disassembled; and

WHEREAS, the cost to purchase and have the "Pulsar" system installed is approximately \$9,000 for the Municipal Pool, \$9,000 for the Centennial Pool and \$7,000 for the Therapy Pool; and

WHEREAS, the FY02/03 two year budget does not currently provide for replacing or repairing these critical disinfections systems

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby approve a one-time appropriation of \$25,000 (50% 100-310-5221-172, 50% 100-310-5221-173 with unspent funds carried over to FY03) for the purchase and installation of new disinfection systems for three pools, and directs staff to seek competitive bids for the project work and to complete the work within the appropriated amount.
