

RESOLUTION NO. 03-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
APPROVING NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR CODE AMENDMENT 02-015
TO PROHIBIT DRIVE-THROUGH RESTAURANTS IN A SPECIFIED GEOGRAPHIC AREA
AND PROVIDE FOR OTHER DRIVE-THROUGH USES CITYWIDE
(CODE AMENDMENT 02-015)

WHEREAS, on September 3, 2002, in conjunction with Code Amendment 02-010, the City Council directed staff to return to the City Council with a Code Amendment that would prohibit drive-through restaurants in the downtown area, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was conducted by the Planning Commission on November 26, 2002 and the City Council on December 17, 2002, to consider facts as presented in the staff report prepared for this project, and to accept public testimony regarding this proposed subdivision, and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of December 17, 2002, the City Council opened the public hearing for proposed ordinance and continued the item to January 21, 2003, in order to increase the geographic area in which drive-through restaurants would be prohibited, and

WHEREAS, the expanded geographic area would include the area generally bounded by 1st Street on the south, 21st Street on the north, Vine Street on the west and Highway 101 on the East, and

WHEREAS, the Code Amendment 02-015 has been noticed in a manner to permit the Planning Commission and City Council to prohibit drive-through restaurants in the specified geographic boundary, but also provide for other drive-through uses that are accessory to banks, coffee kiosks, pharmacies and other similar uses, and

WHEREAS, an Initial Study was prepared for this project and is labeled Exhibit A (on file in the Community Development Department), and

WHEREAS, public notice of the proposed Negative Declaration was given as required by Section 21092 of the Public Resources Code, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that based on the City's independent judgment, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does hereby approve a Negative Declaration for Code Amendment 02-015 in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act.
