

RESOLUTION NO. 03-35

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
AUTHORIZING A BUDGET APPROPRIATION OF \$5,000 FOR THE
SALINAS RIVER ENHANCEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the Federal National Park Service has a Rivers, Trails and Conservation Assistance Program to assist communities by providing expertise and experience to conserve rivers, preserve open space and develop trails and greenways; and

WHEREAS, in July 2002, the City submitted a proposal to the National Park Service requesting assistance in preparing an outreach and mapping project to enhance the Salinas River; and

WHEREAS, in January 2003, the City received notice that the City of Paso Robles has been selected for assistance by the National Park Service Trails Assistance Program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Paso Robles does hereby approve a one-time budget appropriation in the amount of \$5,000 to Budget Account No. 100-310-5235-178 for the Salinas River outreach and mapping project, while reducing Budget Account No. 100-310-5221-349 by \$5,000.
