

RESOLUTION NO. 06-044

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
TO APPROVE ADDITIONAL TRAFFIC CONTROLS (ALL-WAY STOP)
AT THE INTERSECTION OF 10TH STREET AND PINE STREET

WHEREAS, 10th Street and Pine Street are roadways which are moderately traveled and have a large volume of pedestrian traffic due to the local movie theatre; and

WHEREAS, the intersection is currently a two-way stop regulating northbound and southbound traffic on Pine Street; and

WHEREAS, motorists on Pine Street trying to cross 10th Street have a restricted view do to vehicles parked on the curb line causing near collisions on a daily basis; and

WHEREAS, eight traffic collisions have been documented in/or near the intersection since 2001;

WHEREAS, the installation of a four-way stop would increase the safety of motorists and pedestrians on both streets; and

WHEREAS, the Streets and Utilities Committee discussed the issue at length at their February 24, 2006 meeting and voted 1-1 with one approving and the other against the installation; and

WHEREAS, cost is \$450 per sign which includes sign pole and hardware, stop stencil and stop bar. Funds are available from the existing maintenance funds.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does hereby approve additional traffic controls (all-way stop) at the intersection of 10th Street and Pine Street.
