WATER RATES

The water rate is a combined fixed-charge/variable, consumption-based-charge. The per unit usage is the same for every class of customer. Water rates are listed in the following table, with a scheduled increase each January 1st. 1 unit = 100 cubic feet = 748 gallons.

January	<u>2017</u>	<u>2018</u>	<u>2019</u>	<u>2020</u>	<u>2021</u>
Per Unit	\$4.83	\$5.26	\$5.73	\$6.14	\$6.56
Flat Rate	\$5.00	\$6.25	\$7.50	\$8.75	\$10.00

The current rate is \$4.83 per unit (1 unit = 100 cubic feet = 748 gallons) and the current flat rate is \$6.25. To calculate your bill, multiply \$5.26 times the consumption units and add the flat rate charge.

Example #1, if you use 50 units, your monthly bill for water will be \$269.25 (\$5.26 times 50 units, plus the \$6.25 flat rate).

Example #2, if you use 10 units, your monthly bill for water will be \$58.85 (\$5.26 times 10 units, plus the \$6.25 flat rate).

SEWER RATES

Sewer rates for single family homes are based on average monthly metered water use from December, January, and February billing periods. Condominium units served by individual water meters shall be billed as single-family residences. Small multi-family dwellings, defined as buildings containing four or less dwelling units under single ownership, shall be billed as single-family residences.

Multi-family homes comprised of more than four dwelling units under single ownership, commercial establishments, or any other multi-family dwelling that has a separate water meter for outdoor water uses shall be based on metered monthly water use multiplied by the usage charge then in effect.

July	<u>2012</u>	<u>2013</u>	<u>2014</u>	<u>2015</u>	<u>2016</u>
Per Unit	\$4.50	\$5.40	\$6.30	\$7.35	\$7.80

The current rate is \$7.80 per unit (1 unit = 100 cubic feet = 748 gallons). To calculate your bill, multiply \$7.80 times the sewer monthly usage basis units.

Example #1, if your sewer usage basis is 20 units, your monthly bill for sewer will be \$156.00 (\$7.80 times 20 units).

Example #2, if your sewer usage basis is 4 units, your monthly bill for sewer will be \$31.20 (\$7.80 times 4 units).

WATER & SEWER SERVICE FEES & PENALTIES

Examples of these services include a 10% past due penalty, door hanger notification fee for discontinuing water service, meter re-reads, promissory notes, after hour connections, and service nonpayment/restoration fee. The fees are identified as follows:

Routine Door Hanger \$35
Promissory Note \$35
Meter Re-Read \$40*
After Hours Connection \$394**

**New Account Deposit \$99
Special Door Hanger \$45
Nonpayment/Restoration \$99
Bench/Calibration Test \$196*
Hydrant Meter Monthly Rental \$111
Hydrant Meter Relocation \$151**

*** If meter reading is determined to have been misread or meter is reading inaccurately, no fee will be imposed.**

WATER FEES, adopted by City Council 4/05/16 (Ordinance 1025), are effective 1/1/17.

SEWER FEES, adopted by City Council 12/6/11 (Ordinance 975), are effective 7/1/12.

SERVICE FEES & PENALTIES, adopted by City Council 9/20/05 (Resolution 05-192), are effective 7/1/12.
