Based on the popular book series by Darren Shan, this movie is rated PG-13.

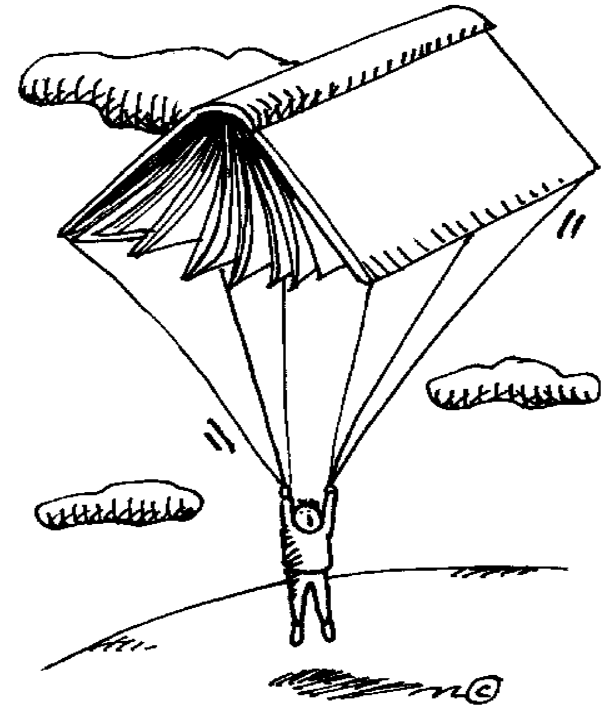
