- 1. FILE #: **CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT 01-004**
 APPLICATION: A proposal to relocate the Tuesday afternoon Farmer's Market activities. The Planning Commission will also be considering the content and potential application of any conditions of approval that relate to the subject application.
 APPLICANT: North County Farmer's Market Association
 LOCATION: 11th Street between Spring and Park Streets (between the Library/City Hall building and the City Park).

2. FILE #: **PLANNED DEVELOPMENT 00-029**
APPLICATION: To consider a proposal to construct a new 5,000 square foot commercial building for carpet sales. The Planning Commission will also be considering the content and potential application of any conditions of approval that relate to the subject application.
APPLICANT: Ted Weber on behalf of Gordon and Sheryl Knight
LOCATION: West side of Ramada Drive across from the new Paris Precision Building.

The Planning Commission will also be considering the content and potential application of any conditions of approval that relate to the subject application.
APPLICANT: Nunno Corporation/Alan Lewis
LOCATION: North of Dry Creek Road, east of Airport Road and south of Taxiway C at the Paso Robles Municipal Airport.
