New City Planning Commissioners Appointed

PASO ROBLES, CA – The Paso Robles City Council has appointed two new members to the Paso Robles Planning Commission, Brice Garrett and Joel Neel. On February 22, 2018, the City Council interviewed 12 applicants to fill two vacant positions on the Planning Commission. Mr. Garrett and Mr. Neel were selected based on their applications, interviews and their ability to represent a wide range of community views and interests.
